most beautiful excursions is a visit to the Sunken City of Kekova, located in a sheltered bay.

The water is so clear that the ruins can be seen easily in this breathtaking cove, which you can only explore in a boat, dinghy or sea kayak. While that may sound like a lot on your to-do list, there's plenty of down time to be enjoyed. That and knock-out food! Think Mediterranean flavours with lots of seafood and tasty vegetable dishes, like garlicky tomatoes and grilled aubergine and red peppers infused with the region's famous olive oil.
